

## **Public Service Announcement from the Haliburton Highlands Land Trust**

Important information for enjoying winter visits to Barnum Creek Nature Reserve

The entrance gate to Barnum Creek N.R. is closed in winter and needs to be left clear of vehicles for emergency access.

Gould Crossing Road is not ploughed or maintained. The hill is very steep and slippery so we advise that you do not drive up even if the snow is not deep.

In order to access Barnum Creek N.R. in winter, limited parking is available along the side of Gould Crossing Road. Please respect all driveways and do not park in the snowplough turn around area.

The hike up Gould Crossing Road is short (about 5-10 minutes) but quite steep so please use caution and take your time if this is your first visit. It is a multi-use road so keep to the side of the road.

When you visit Dahl Forest in winter, please observe the Snowplough Turnaround signage and park along the north side of the road.
